General Appearance

Dress Neatly - That is, all shirts tucked in, shoes tied, no holes/tears/stains on clothes, missing buttons promptly replaced, and clothing appropriately sized for the wearer.

- Shirts must be buttoned to just below the neck
- No midriff/back/undergarments showing
- No hats indoors
- Hair must be natural and clean; no unnatural colors or styles that interfere with learning
 - Boys' hair must be neatly groomed, out of the face and eyes, no long spikes, and head is not to be shaved
- Modest hair accessories must be either school colors or black, white, silver, or gold
- Girls: max 2 earrings/ear (max: 1.5" hoops)
- Boys: no earrings
- Other piercings (including nose rings) are not allowed
- Limit jewelry to 1 per limb
 - Boys may not wear any distracting jewelry other than a watch, modest necklace, bracelet, or ring (i.e., wristbands, anklets, or other accessories)
- No cosmetics
- Single, solid color nail polish is allowed
 - No artificial nails
- Tattoos, real or play, must be covered

Why A **Uniform?**

Liberty Christian Classical School sets a high standard for students in their dress and appearance to express reverence for God and for the task of education and to demonstrate respect for one another.

A uniform policy promotes strong personal habits, the honor of self and others, modesty, and discipline.

Adherence to the policy diminishes economic and social barriers between students, increases a sense of belonging and school pride, encourages good judgment, models good citizenship, and encourages all to perform at their highest level.

Liberty encourages parents to hold their children accountable for adhering to the uniform and dress code policy. When teachers must address infractions, precious time reserved for education is wasted. Uniform policy adherence is primarily the responsibility of the family at home.

Students are expected to be in uniform when on campus unless a rare occasion has been designated by school administration. Students will also wear their uniforms on most field trips and outings that occur during a typical school day. The uniform is governed by the following biblical principles:





Why A Uniform?

1. The way we dress can honor God by reflecting respect for our bodies and for others or can dishonor God by showing disrespect for our bodies and others. (1 Corinthians 6:20)
2. We should not dress in a manner that draws self-gratifying attention. Instead we should be Christ-like in both conduct and dress. (Romans 13:14)
3. We should not view our physical appearance or beauty as the source of our value, but rather should see that our value is inherent as God's unique creation. We should strive to let our attractiveness emanate from a Christlike spirit and good conduct. (1 Peter 3:3-4; 1 Timothy 2:9-10; Colossians 3:17)
4. All students must dress in uniform clothing designated by the academy for their biological, genetic sex confirmed at birth. (Genesis 1:27; Deut. 22:5)

Students are encouraged to honor the stated and implied principles of the uniform. We strongly discourage the practice of looking for loopholes and of applying a legalistic approach to the uniform in both practice and enforcement. Teachers do not enjoy reprimanding students and find even more distasteful debating with them over the uniform standards. Let's work together to make the uniform a useful tool.

Non-Uniform Attire

For both on-campus and off-campus events sponsored by the school and not requiring uniform clothing, the following rules apply:

- No yoga pants, biker shorts, skinny jeans, or ripped clothing
- Shorts must be fingertip-length; dresses/skirts must hit knee
- No tank tops, tight tops, plunging necklines, or bare midriffs
- Writing or images should be “Grated” and should not state or imply messages that would be in conflict with the school’s mission
- No 2-piece swimsuits or male speedos
